NEW for Tuesdays, Shoppers' Bus, The Upper Colne to Haverhill Bus, leaves Birdbrook Church 11:33am arrives back 14:22. Because there is little use by some villages we understand the route is being changed and this bus will now call at Steeple Bumpstead. Birdbrook is not affected and we assume the times are the same. Don't forget "Use it or lose it."

Don't forget availability of new Wednesday Bus Service 89A. The grant has been extended for a further year.

From 4th August the middle day bus leaves Haverhill one hour earlier, 12:25 and not 13:25 and operates one hour earlier throughout.

Please note that as last year this service will not operate on the Wednesday between Christmas and New Year i.e. no 89A service on Weds. 29th Dec 2010.
